Conveyor Lubricant

Product Description:

SUPER LOOB is a premium, water-soluble lubricant for use in food, dairy, and beverage plants as a chain, case, and bottle conveyor lubricant. SUPER LOOB is formulated to optimise detergency, lubrication and stability in hard water.

Advantages:

SUPER LOOB can save the user time and money via four main 'key properties':

- Concentrated product for efficient use dilution
- Detergent based, cleans tracks in use.
- Low foaming, so no messy residual / clean up.
- Insensitive to hard water

Application:

SUPER LOOB is typically diluted between 1:100 and 1: 500 (0.2 to 1.0%) with water. Final dilution to be determined based on conveyor type, soil loading, line configuration, type of chain and other factors.

SUPER LOOB should be added via your conveyors automatic dosing application system. SUPER LOOB is cationic in nature so may not mix with other conveyor lubricants. We recommend a complete flush of lines before initial usage of SUPER LOOB. Failure to flush lines could lead to gelling / line plugging. SUPER LOOB is compatible with all conveyor materials of construction.
