This is to certify that Isopropanol 70% does not contain, is not derived from, and is not manufactured using any of the following known allergens as defined by regulatory authorities including FSANZ (Australia/New Zealand), the European Union (EU), and the U.S. FDA:

- Cereals containing gluten (e.g., wheat, rye, barley, oats)
- Crustacea and crustacean products
- Egg and egg products
- Fish and fish products
- Milk and milk products (including lactose)
- Peanuts and peanut products
- Soybeans and soybean products
- Tree nuts and tree nut products
- Sesame seeds and sesame seed products
- Sulphites in concentrations ≥ 10 mg/kg
- Lupin and lupin products
- Molluscs and mollusc products

Isopropanol is a synthetic chemical compound produced via petrochemical processes (typically from propene and water), and it is not of biological origin. It contains no proteins or protein residues and therefore poses no risk of allergenicity related to food or contact allergens.
