Castle Chemicals is aware that some products supplied for commercial & institutional cleaning are rated as “Hazardous” or “Dangerous Goods”.

Our Technical Manager is assigned the task of keeping all our Work Health and Safety documents up to date with the Work Cover & Work Safe requirements. The documents that interact with our customers and that he has responsibility for are –

Safety Data Sheets

Product Labels

Product Data Sheet (Technical Bulletins)

EPG forms (Transport Emergency Procedure Guides)

For every delivery of goods Castle Chemicals uses a combination of sub-contractors and employees. The Sub-contract Carriers we use are approved to carry DG items and our own Employees have been trained in the transport of DG items.

Castle Chemicals is not a Work Cover licensed consultant for storage of dangerous goods. Castle Chemicals Employees are not authorized to give advice on storage issues. We can only make suggestions. We suggest that Customers requiring advice on storage of DG items should approach Work Cover for the names of licensed consultants in their area.

Castle Chemicals recognizes that some cleaning applications require DG products to produce the most economical in use costs for our Customers. Castle Chemicals has a policy of reducing the opportunity for Customers Staff to be in contact with DG products through our Dispensing Systems and Training. We have developed and introduced our GreenPro Range of products, these products have been third party approved to meet Environmental Accreditation.
