This letter serves as information relating to the supply, by Castle Post Harvest Products, of fruit and vegetable processing and waxing chemicals to the food industry. Specifically in this instance:

Apple Gloss

In common with most vegetables and fruits, citrus and apple fruits are routinely waxed to both aid moisture retention, preservation and hence extended shelf life. Wax coating also improve the aesthetic appearance of the fruit.

The thorough washing and cleaning that occurs in the pack house following picking often removes the fruits' natural surface waxes and slightly dulls their appearance. Out naturally derived fruit coatings restore this and provide the appearance the consumer both expects and desires.

I can confirm that the raw materials in our fruit coating products are both naturally derived, I.E. Carnauba wax and/or Shellac, and/or approved ingredients to meet Food Safety Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) Food Standards Code Standard 3.2.1 Food Safety Programs.

For export, we also meet the requirements of US FDA CFR's (Food and Drugs Administration, Code of Federal regulation) for fruit coatings.

To this end, we **do not** add any known allergens to our products and the quality and specification of our raw materials means we are not knowingly supplying allergen-bearing materials.

I hope that this information meets with your requirements, and helps to clarify this issue. Castle are proud to have been supplying these quality assured products to the fruit industry for the last thirty years.
